Dietary requirements (including those for religious observance) can be catered for. However parents need to complete Herts. form on line.

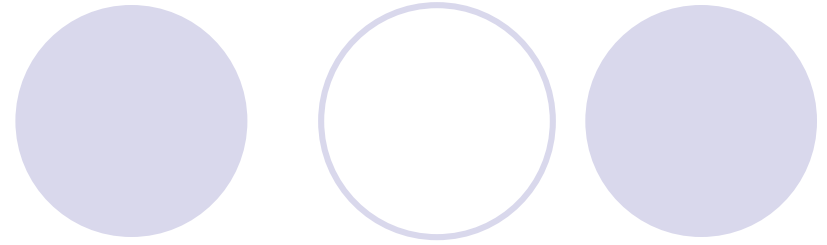


Equipment

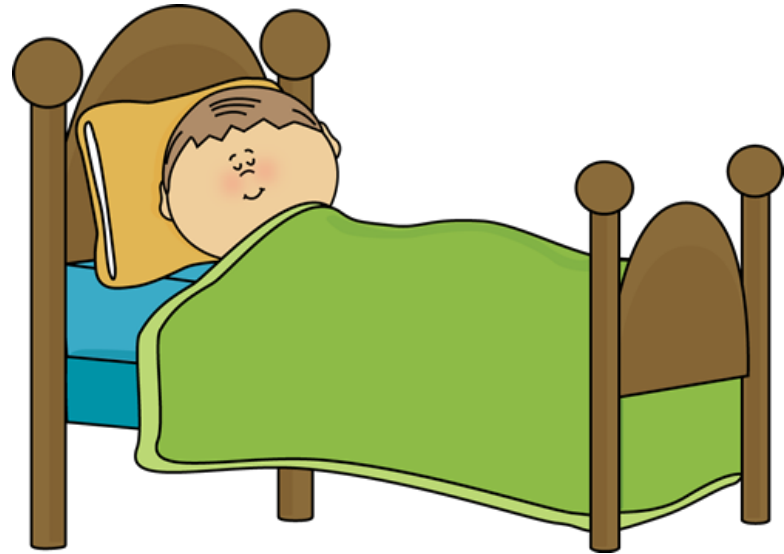
Full equipment list will be sent out closer to the time.
